



I AM YOUR PRIVATE DANCER is a multimedia light and mirror object. It formally refers to elements of light from striptease saloons and nightclubs and is inspired by the essay "Strip-tease" by Roland Barthes. The programming, which is controlled via an app shows a text passage from Tina Turner's homonymous song, "Tell me do you want to see me doing the shimmy again," alternating with symbols, such as hearts, dollar signs and stars.
