Ocean View Apartment on Fisher Island: Holzrausch Studio Design

has completed its latest project – a residence on Fisher Island in Florida. In the ocean-view apartment, warm wood and travertine tones help create an expressive backdrop for design and art objects.

The studio's project is based on the idea of creating a free and "fluid" living space, where the boundaries between functional areas - a shared kitchen-living room, a private study and bedroom - are softened and blurred. The elongated volumes of the rooms enhance the feeling of spaciousness and integrity.



The designers saw their task as creating a system of "isolated volumes", where each zone is endowed with its own functions, but at the same time remains part of a single composition. Such an architectural strategy made it possible to avoid fragmentation of space.





The minimalist approach to the choice of materials emphasizes the status of the interior, allowing works of art to enter into a dialogue with the architecture. The neutral palette maintains the visual integrity of the apartment.



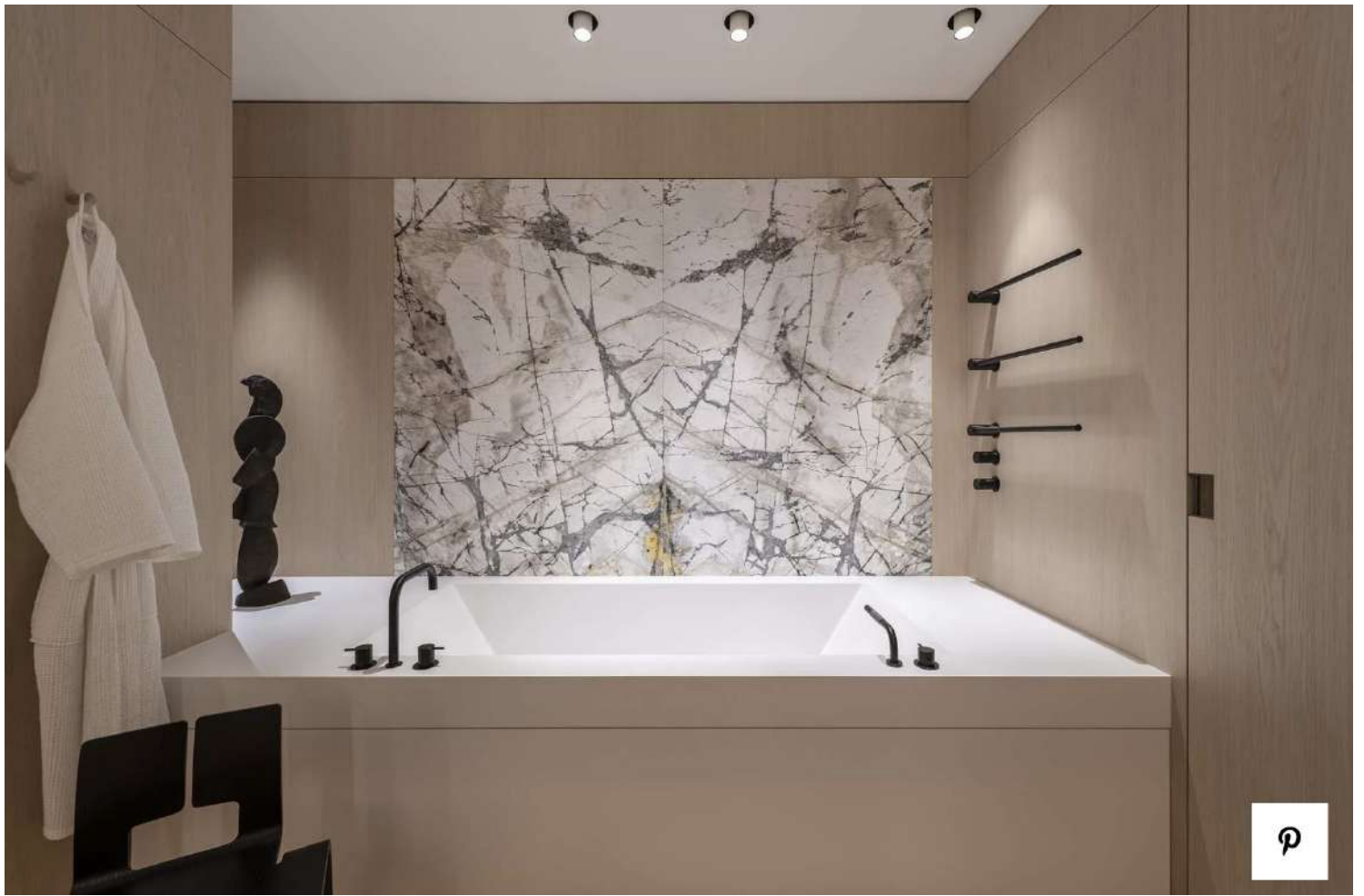


Oak panels serve as a sophisticated backdrop for the objects that fill the interior. The floors are finished with textured travertine with a porous structure. Bright accents in the decor bring dynamics to the project, but allow you to maintain the overall light and harmonious mood. The combination of modern architecture, craft objects and minimalist aesthetics creates the perfect balance for living and relaxing on the ocean shore.
